

1: *Pertains to God*; Using the number one makes it to where there can be no differences as there is no second or third option that can be in conflict with the one, the 1st commandment pertains to God (Exodus 20:3), (Isaiah 44:6)

2: *Separation*; Number of Witnesses or Opposites; 2nd day of creation was characterized by division (Genesis 1:6), in the new testament, whenever there are two epistles, the second has a special reference to an opposite

3: *Divine Perfection*; 3rd day that Jesus was perfected (Luke 13:32), Matthew 3 & 17 and John 12 are the three times God spoke from heaven talking about Jesus

4: *Denotes the Creative Works of God*; Parable of the sower Matthew 13

5: *Grace or Mercy*; Abraham's name changed using the 5th number of the Hebrew alphabet (Genesis 17), David used 5 stones against Goliath (1st Samuel 17:40)

6: *Flesh or Man*; (Revelations 13: 16 – 18), Kingdom of Men, Nimrod was the first offspring of the serpent that had real power (Genesis 10)

Red: *Refers to the Flesh*; Esau represented the flesh (Genesis 25:25)

Yellow: *Speaks of Trial and Purging*; Gold tried by fire (1st Peter 1:7)

Blue: *The Word and/or Healing Power of God*; Looking at the band of blue they will remember Yahweh's Commandments (Numbers 15:38-41)

Green: *Immortality*; Aaron's rod that budded (Numbers 17:8)

Purple: *Royalty or Priesthood*; They put Christ in a purple robe (Mark 15:17)
